The unaudited interim financial results and other unaudited financial information of the associate has been reviewed by its independent auditor and has been approved and furnished to us by the Management of the Parent Company and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures in respect of the associate, is based solely on such unaudited interim financial results and other unaudited financial information. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial results are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion on the Statement in respect of matters stated in para above is not modified with respect to our reliance on the work done and the financial results certified by the Management.
